Membership is open to all majors, not just business majors, and membership in other campus organizations (including social Greek organizations) is encouraged.




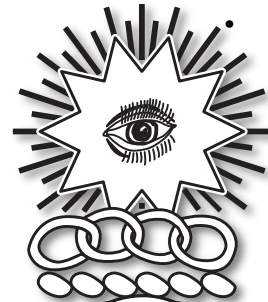
